Hours of Service for Entrance and Clearance

This remote airport is serviced by the Alcan, AK POE. Limited inspection services for entrance/arrival of aircraft at PAOR are available 0900 and 1500 hours/7 days a week in accordance with the port's permission to land procedures.

Commercial aircraft operators departing the U.S. must obtain an outbound clearance by contacting CBP directly.

Permission to Land Procedures

Northway Airport (PAOR) is designated as a "landing rights airport" [19 CFR 122.1(f);19 CFR 122.14].



Pilots must secure permission to land by contacting CBP prior to departure from foreign and at least 2 hours in advance of the anticipated arrival time at Northway Airport. Permission to land is granted with a tolerance of (+/-) 30 minutes. If your ETA deviates outside those parameters, you must contact CBP to resecure permission to land.

Inspection Process

- Aircraft should park on the tarmac.
- There is no CBP office at the location.
- A CBP officer will meet the aircraft on the tarmac to begin the inspection.
- All crew and passengers will be processed planeside.
- All crew and passengers will present their own passports, visas, pilot's license, medical certificate, aircraft registration and user fee decal
- There is no USDA compliance agreement in place at Northway Airport for the collection of regulated waste/garbage.
- Only aircraft arriving from Canada can be served by CBP at this airport.



Special Procedures/Miscellaneous

- CBP Officers travel from the Alcan Port of Entry, AK to process arriving aircraft at this airport; accurate ETAs and timely updates for ETAs are essential.
- Hours and seasonal coverage vary depending on conditions
- Advise CBP if you are transporting firearms, animals, wildlife products (meat, hides, etc.) or commercial products.
- Advise CBP if the aircraft is being imported into the United States.
